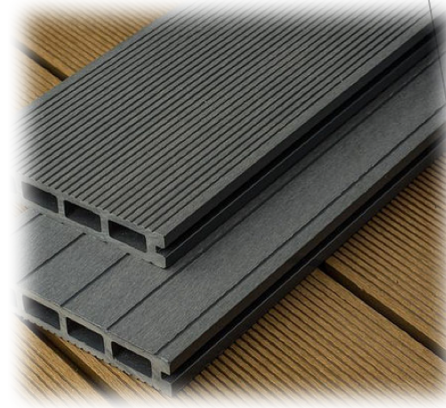
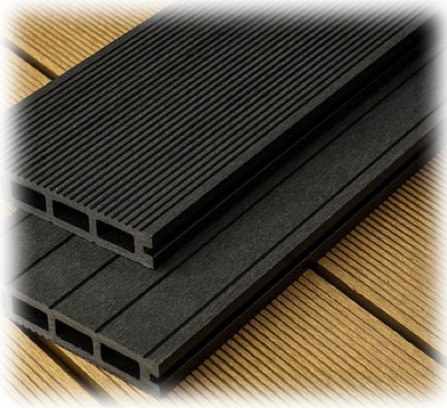

Our hollow core composite decking boards have a lightweight honeycomb construction and are reversible with narrow spaced grooves on one side and wider spaced grooves on the other. Both sides provide a robust anti-slip walking surface, are easy to clean, and require very little maintenance. Our planks comes in a 5800mm x 150mm x 25mm and is best suited for larger decking areas where a single length of 5.8m can be used to minimize visible joins.

T-CLIP FASTENING SYSTEM



STEP 1 - Take your screws and hand tighten it into the clip to make a set.

STEP 2 - Once your composite decking plank is cut to size and in place.

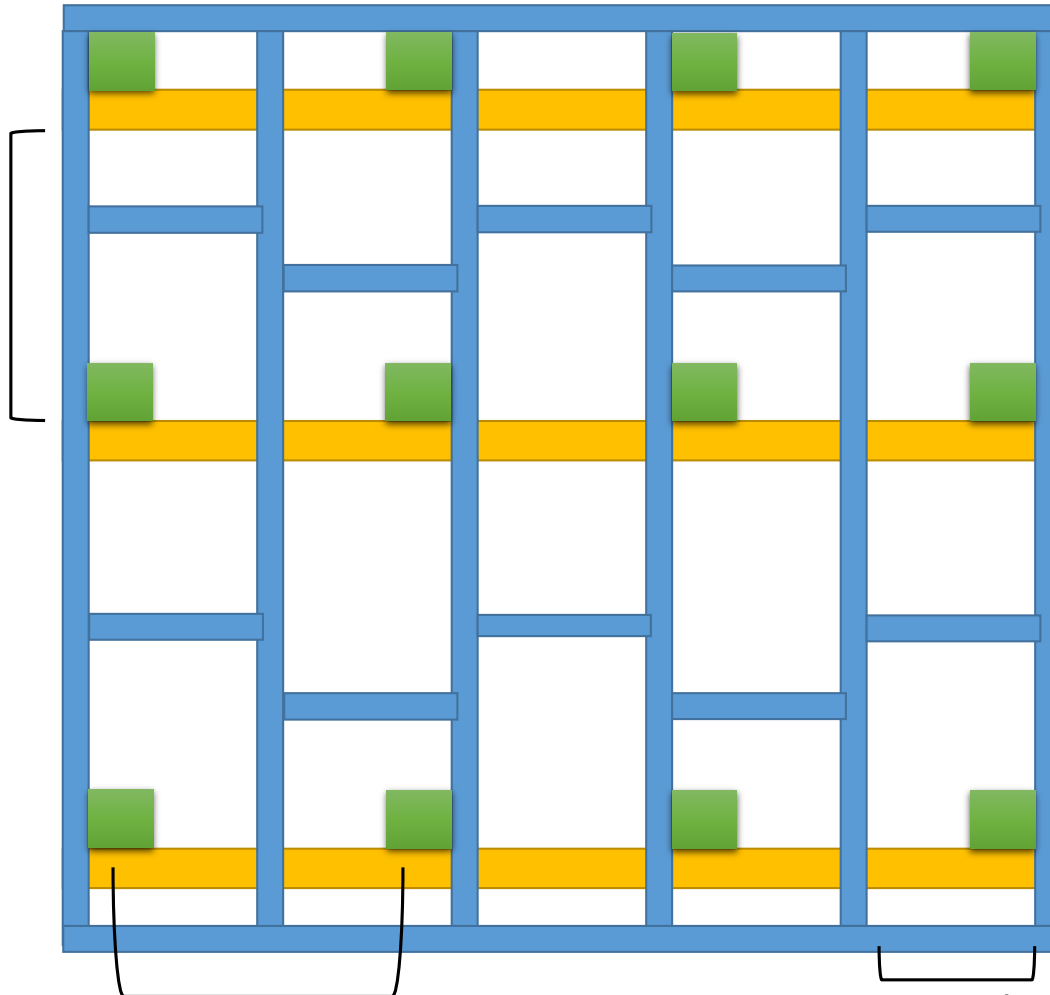
Take your made up clip and place it tightly against the plank on the cross joist of your frame.

Once lined up tightly drive the screw through the clip till the screw just applies pressure onto the clip.



STRUCTURE INSTALLATION.

Top view



50 x 228mm beams will be spaced 800mm from each other.

My 350mm support spacers will be steps and every 800mm from each row.

120 x 120 legs will be spaced 1m from each other.

50 x 152mm beams will be 350 mm spaces.
